Gaffney, Robin grew up in Honolulu and spent many wonderful weekends and holidays at Malaekahana. She graduated from Punahou School with the class 1969 and from the University of Denver in 1973, after which she went to work in the fashion industry. Robin moved to Hana, Maui in 1987 to help care for her recently disabled mother, and in 1989 met her long-term partner, woodworker Gaylord Stadshaug, who was at her side until the end. Robin was gracious, generous, and a reliable friend to the many who crossed paths with her during her 71 years.
