Over the years, she actively contributed to Maui by working with the ILWU and retired as a bartender at the Royal Lahaina Hotel. She was also an enthusiastic participant in the Kaunoa Senior Center hula halau and enjoyed playing tennis, which brought her immense joy.

Glorin is survived by her brother Pete Calpito and five children: Doreen Alboro, Sandra Alboro, Laura Yamashiro-Alboro (Dean Owan), Faustino Jr. (Lori Koyama-Alboro), and Ricardo Alboro.
