# Pumehana Kealoha Cobb-Adams

**P**umehana Kealoha Cobb-Adams, 76, of Kula, Maui, went home to be with Our Lord on September 17, 2024. She was surrounded by her children, grandchildren, great-grandchildren and great-great-grandchild, and her room was filled with an overwhelming presence of love, worship and prayer.

Born on September 10, 1948, in Honolulu, Hawaii, Pumehana was the daughter of the late George and Elizabeth (Mahelona) Rogers. She is predeceased by her 6 brothers and 1 sister, and is survived by her sister, Elizabeth H. Lau.

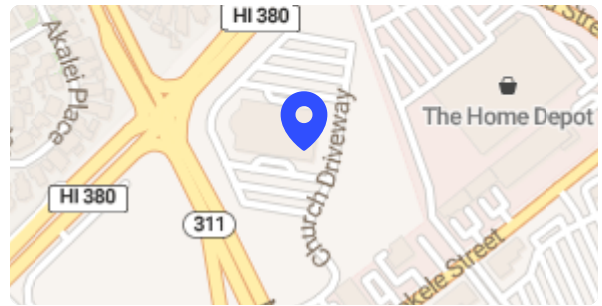

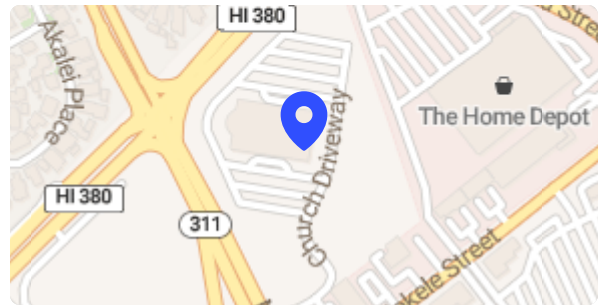
