Jose Calma Villanueva, 92, passed peacefully at Hospice Maui surrounded by his family on September 26, 2024. He is predeceased by Ines Villanueva on April 1, 2011.

Jose was born on July 2, 1932 in Bacarra, Ilocos Norte, Philippines to Mateo and Irene Villanueva. Jose moved to Waikapu, Maui on April 23, 1978. He started off as a farm hand at the Dole Plantation. Shortly after moving to Hawai'i he realized that he did not want to be working in the fields, so he changed his profession to Kitchen Steward at the Royal Lahaina Resort. On his days off, he would do landscaping with his wife, Ines, and sometimes their grandchildren in tow around their neighborhood.
