Kaulangi Ngatuvai Finau, born in Vava'u, Tonga on November 16, 1964, peacefully passed away on October 28, 2024. She was the beloved daughter of the late Saulala and Anau Suli Ngatuvai and the cherished youngest of five siblings.

In 1991, Kaulangi and her husband, Siosaia Fisi'ihoi Finau, moved to Lahaina, Hawaii, where they welcomed their daughter, Lupe Lei'aloaha Leha, in 1995. Kaulangi was a devoted mother and grandmother, nurturing her family with unwavering love and support. 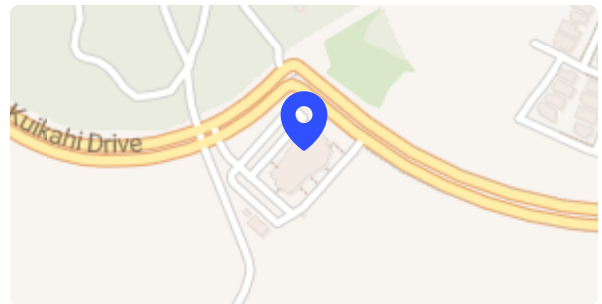

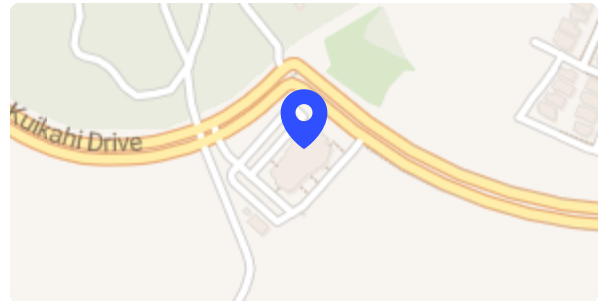

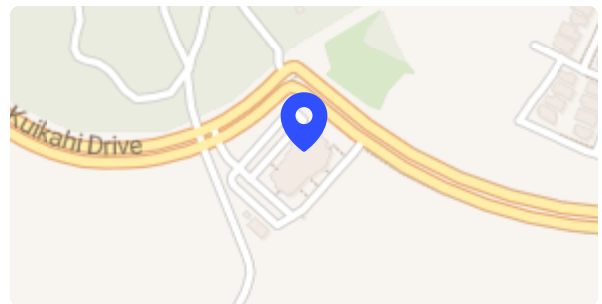
