Samuel G. Oda, 61, of Wailuku, HI passed away in Kahului under the kind and patient care of Islands Hospice.

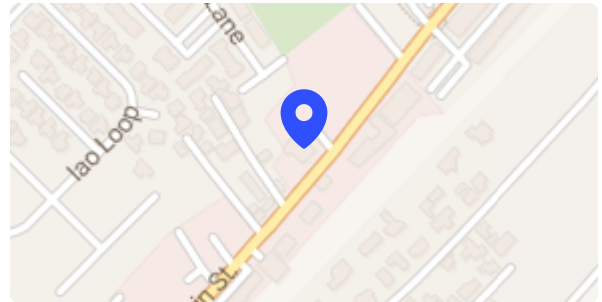

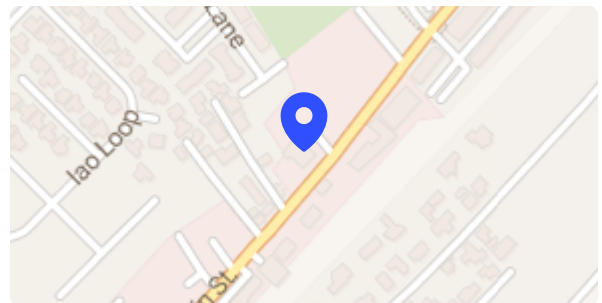
