Service will be held at Nakamura Mortuary, May 14, 2025, Visitation at 2PM and Service at 2:30pm.



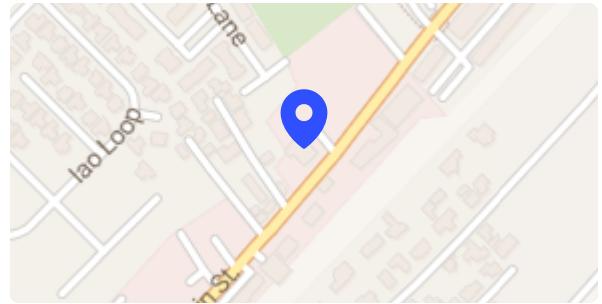

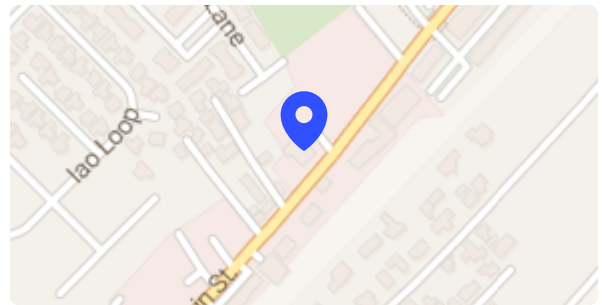
