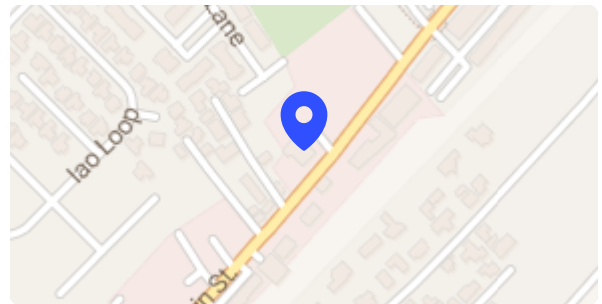

She had an uncanny ability to be very proper, lady like and perfectly well spoken, while knowing how to bus'up people laughing and sometimes vent her frustrations- all in such a charming way. I learned so much about plantation life and old Hawaii and I always knew that she was pretty much a relic from the past and that there would never be anyone else like her, ever again. 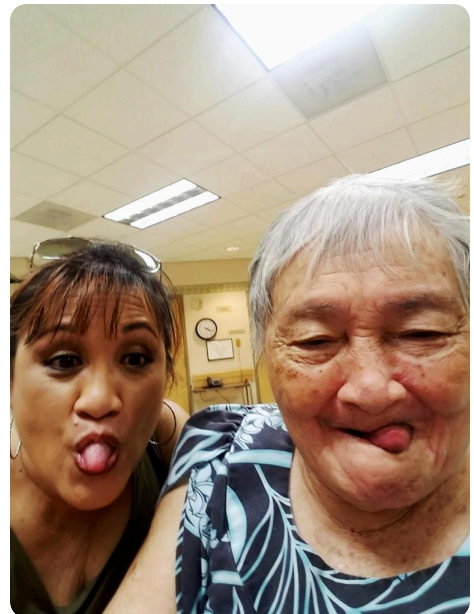

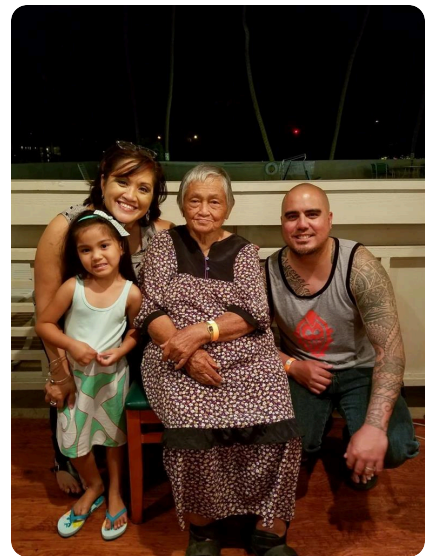
