The Quemado family want to extend their gratitude to Hospice Maui & to Luisa Ogawa, Kaiser NP.






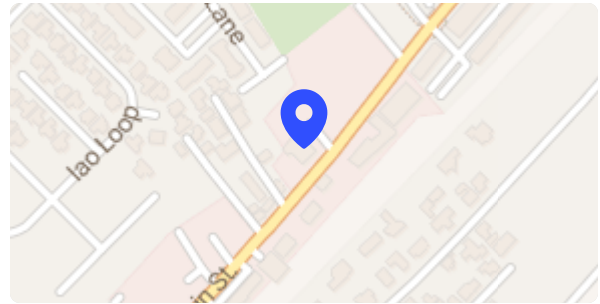

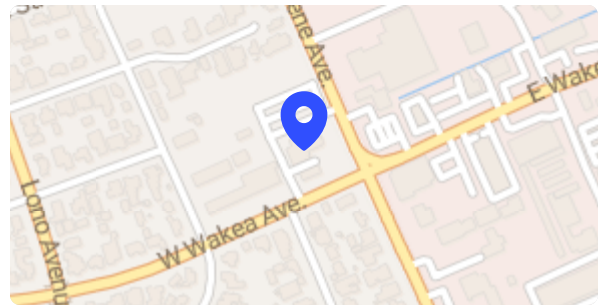

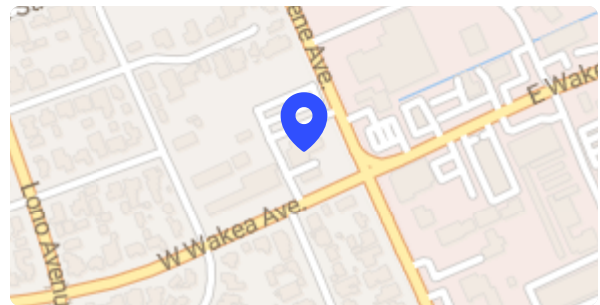
