He graduated from an alternative high school where he baked bread for credits. Tony also grew into a very talented guitarist into his adult years.

Tony was a valued employee at Rabano Co. in Seattle as a skilled mechanic, welder, & metal worker. A member of The Automotive Machinist Union Local 289, his employer Dave Rogers said, “I remember Tony helping me out a lot when I 1st started out, he was a good guy.”
